



Attention Drivers

With the rising cost of fuel and no end in sight, we need your help!

Allow trucks to warm up while doing your pre-trip inspection. **AFTER THAT, STOP ALL UNNECESSARY IDLING!**

When you reach your destination after a full load operation, allow the engine to idle 3 minutes before shutting it off.

After a light load operation, allow 1 minute before shutting it off. This allows adequate cool down of pistons, cylinders, bearings, and turbocharger components.

The law says we CAN NOT idle our trucks for more than five minutes unless the vehicle is to remain motionless for more than 2 hours and the outside temp is below 25 degrees. This is considered a MISDEMEANOR.
